Preventive measures and rules of conduct

Keep out of reach of children.

The cryptocrystalline

portion of silicic acid may cause generate fine dust during the application after evaporation of the water-solvent mixture. Danger of silicosis by prolonged exposure through inhalation.

Respiratory protection:

If vapours form, use respiratory protection.

Use filter type A according to EN 14387.

In case of dust formation: Half mask with particle filter FFP2 according to EN 143.

Hand protection:

Protective gloves according to EN 374.

Long-term:

Glove material: PVC-Layer thickness: 0.7 mm

Breakthrough time: > 480 min.

Short-term:

Glove material: PVC-Layer thickness: 0.4 mm

Breakthrough time: > 30 min.

Observe glove manufacturer's instructions concerning penetrability and breakthrough time.

Eye protection:

Tightly sealed goggles according to EN 166.

Body protection:

Wear suitable protective clothing.

Reaction in case of danger

Provide adequate ventilation. Keep unprotected people away.

Do not breathe dust/fume/gas/mist/vapours/spray.

Avoid contact with the substance. Wear appropriate protective equipment.

Extinguishing media:

Water spray jet, foam, extinguishing powder, carbon dioxide.

Extinguishing media which must not be used for safety reasons:

Full water jet

Accidental release measures:

Absorb with liquid-binding material (e.g. sand, diatomaceous earth, acid- or universal binding agents) and place in closed containers for disposal.

First aid

General information: Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse.

In case of inhalation: Provide fresh air. If the casualty has difficulty breathing, call a doctor immediately.

Following skin contact: After contact with skin, wash immediately with plenty of water. In case of skin reactions, consult a physician.

After eye contact: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of flowing water for 10 to 15 minutes holding eyelids apart. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Subsequently consult an ophthalmologist.

After swallowing: Rinse mouth. Do not induce vomiting. Risk of foam aspiration when vomiting. Risk of suffocation! Immediately get medical attention.
